Tennis Rules

As approved by the Board of Directors, Sea Ranch Club Condominium Association, Inc.
Revised May 17, 2023

1. Courts must be reserved at the **Front Desk of Building C (954-785-9506)** no more than 24 hours in advance **to the exact minute**. Time of play is limited to a maximum 1 hour for single games and 2 hours for doubles. To reserve the second hour of a singles game, one **must** call again 24 hours in advance.
2. Lessons and the use of the courts are limited to owners, lessees, and their guests.
3. For safety and security reasons, it is important that the tennis court gates remain closed at all times.
4. Hours of play are from 8:00 am until dusk.
5. Courts 7 and 8 are reserved for the tennis club every Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday from 8 am to 10 am.
6. Residents and guests may take lessons from a tennis professional on Court 6. Play can be reserved any day no more than 48 hours in advance. The teaching professional must have a certification, an occupational license, and carry insurance. Court 6 may be reserved for tennis clinic on Thursdays from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm in high season which runs from December 1st through April 30th.
7. If a player is more than 15 minutes late, the reservation is forfeited.
8. If a player cannot use his/her reservation, he/she must cancel it.
9. Individuals wishing to give lessons (for profit) must be approved by the Association Areas Committee. Reservations for the lessons must be made by the recipient of the lessons, not by the instructor.
10. Players must wear regulation tennis attire and shoes defined as shirts, shorts, skirts, dresses, pants, jackets and any other outerwear and shoes specifically manufactured for playing tennis.
11. No more than four 4 tennis balls may be used on any one court, except during tennis classes or when using the ball machine.
12. Players may not cross behind another court, or return a ball while play is in progress. When it is clear, they may do so expeditiously.
13. Only people playing tennis are allowed on courts while play is in progress. Individuals not actually playing tennis are not permitted on the tennis courts while any court is in use.
14. The tennis benches shall be used solely as seating for players and shall not be used to store personal items. Personal items may be placed under the benches or along the east and west side fences of the tennis courts.
15. All tournaments and reservations of courts for tournaments must be approved by the Association Areas Committee before advertising or scheduling any tournament. Any entry fees for tournaments must be collected by the Social Committee sponsoring the event.
16. The SRC Association ball machine may be used only by an adult resident who has been instructed in its use by an individual designated by the Association Areas Committee.
